

How should a church member give to the church?

**1 Our giving should be regular and intentional.** The biblical idea is not simply putting some money in the plate as the mood strikes us or as it seems good to us to give. Instead, we should think through our giving, plan for our giving, and give regularly as a habit. Paul wrote to the Corinthians, *“On the first day of every week, each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper...”* (1 Corinthians 16:2)

**2 Our giving should be proportional.** That same teaching shows us that we should give according to the way God has prospered us. The best starting place for our giving should be the tithe, which is 10% of our gross income to the work of the Lord.

We encourage you to begin your commitment to regular and proportional giving. One way to make that easy for you is to give online by setting up a regularly scheduled amount of money to come out of your bank account or charged to your debit card.

This brochure is designed to walk you through setting up your e-giving account. It is totally private and under your control. The church will receive notice of your gift, so you do not have to place anything in the offering plate. If you wish, you can print the receipt and drop it in the plate as it is passed by you.

After you are taken to the E-Giving login page, you can start the process by creating an account. Simply click on the link labeled, "Create an account" in the upper left of the screen.

Or click on the link labeled, "Not signed up yet? Sign up here!" to create an account and start the process.



**What is E-Giving?**

E-Giving is short for electronic giving. It is an automatic transfer program that allows you to make contributions without the hassle of writing checks.

**How does it work?**

Go to our website, [cfmiami.org/giving](http://cfmiami.org/giving) and click on "Giving." Then, simply follow the directions to authorize an ACH deduction. You can make a donation via your checking, savings account, or credit/debit card. It will be transferred directly to the church's account.

**What if I make a mistake during the process?** No problem, you will have a chance to confirm, cancel, or change any transaction before it's submitted.

**How often will the amount be deducted from my account?** That's up to you. You can make a one-time donation or set up recurring donations.

**What if I try it and I don't like it?** You can cancel your automatic deduction schedule on the website at any time.
